By Regulation 14 for the degree of Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine [*Ordinances*, p. 506] no certificate of diligent attendance at these courses is acceptable in so far as it relates to any period before the candidate passed or gained exemption from the Qualifying Examination.

These courses will be given at the Veterinary School unless otherwise stated, and will begin on the Monday which next precedes the first day of Full Term.
